



Just after Christmas, the next holiday will be New Year's. With the beginning of 2011 comes a time of reflection, followed





The IG Training Available at the Lake! IG Competition Entry Deadline is March 1

Are you ready for some competition?

The Individual Growth Committee encourages all of our local associations to highlight a BWM member and assist her in preparing to be part of the IG Speech Competition this year at our spring convention. The entry deadline is March 1, 2011. Any member who is designated by a local club as a local winner and who meets the competition criteria of being a member in good standing; living, working or continuing education in the area served by the local association; having completed the IG modules in the last 5 years; and supporting the BWM mission and vision is eligible to participate. Participants must also pledge that she will not speak against the BWM legislative platform issues in her capacities as representatives of the local club and the BWM.

The local Heart of the Ozarks club will be offering Modules 8-15 on February 29 from 9 a.m until 4 p.m. at the Lake of the Ozarks. The cost is \$40 for all materials, breakfast sweets and coffee, lunch, door prizes and snacks throughout the day. The training will be led by Deborah Brasfield, a nationally certified trainer. If you have a member who is interested in participating in the IG Speech Competition who has not had training in any of the modules, please encourage them to attend. Arrangements can also be made to do modules 1-7 prior to March 1, 2011 if there is enough interest.

REMINDER (the following is a repeat from last issue) Any member who is designated by a local club as a local winner and who meets the competition criteria. . . should complete the IG Participation form from page 75 of the local manual and submit it to Peggy Cochran, P. O. Box 890, Rocky Mount, MO 65072 by March 1, 2011.

There will be three components to the competition:

- Participants will be asked to deliver a 5 minute prepared speech on one of the following topics at the State Conference: Equal Rights Amendment, Pay Equity, Educational Equity and Funding, Health Care Reform, Domestic Violence, Reproductive Choice, Mentoring, Women in Politics, Appreciating Diversity, Dependent Care for Persons of all Ages and Access to Mental Health Care.
- 2. Participants should be prepared to deliver a 2 minute impromptu speech. Subjects will be drawn at random at the state competition.
- 3. Participants will undergo a personal interview and be judged on their demeanor, answers, skills, talents, etc.
- C. Have completed the IG modules within the preceding 5 years.
- D. Support the BWM mission and vision and pledge that she will not speak against the BWM legislative platform issues in their capacities as representatives of the local club and the BWM.

We are looking forward to a wonderful and healthy competition at our BWM State Conference in April, 2011.

News from Three Rivers Local Club



A Message from the Women's Health Chair

How many of you can remember going to Grandma's house for Thanksgiving or Christmas and having those good old jelled cranberries from a can served on a very petty plate? Well I can! You know that cranberries are good for us.

The North American cranberry contains unique A-linked proanthocyanidins (PACs) that have an anti-adhesion mechanism, preventing certain bacteria from adhering to cells throughout the body and removing their potential to cause infection. With a rich combination of nutrients, polyphones, fiber, vitamin c and quercetin, the cranberry offers truly multidimensional health benefits. In plan English cranberries are filled with antioxidants that provide health benefits to the immune system.

Here is a recipe that I have found for the ho-hum cranberry sauce of yesterday.

Pecan Cranberry Salad Makes 12 servings

- 1 15- ounce can crushed pineapple, drained, 1 cup of juice reserved
- cup water
- 3-ounce package orange gelatin
- 3-ounce package cherry gelatin
- 1 16-ounce can whole-berry cranberry sauce
- 6-ounce can frozen orange juice concentrate
- 1 cup chopped pecans or walnuts

½ cup chopped celery (optional)

Spray a 6-cup mold with non-stick cooking spray.

Combine reserved pineapple juice and water in a small sauce-pan; bring to a boil and remove from heat. Pour juice mixture into a large bowl and add gelatins; stir until dissolved. Add drained pineapple, cranberry sauce, orange juice concentrate, nuts, and celery, and mix well. Pour gelatin mixture into mold and refrigerate until firm. Enjoy
